ORDINANCE NO. 485

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 101- BOATS AND BOATING, §101-2.

MOORING AT PUBLIC WHARVES.,OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF ST. MICHAELS

TO REGULATE THE MOORING OF BOATS TO THE PUBLIC WHARF AT HOLLIS

PARK

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of St. Michaels are empowered to regulate the operation and mooring of boats and vessels upon the waterways within the Town pursuant to Maryland Annotated Code, Local Government Code, Division 11, and the Charter of the Town of St. Michaels (1980), Article III, Section 1 (1) and (39);

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of St. Michaels deem the uncontrolled and unregulated mooring of boats and vessels to public wharves within the Town of St. Michaels in violation of the public health, safety, comfort, convenience, welfare and happiness of the residents and visitors of the Town of St. Michaels;

SECTION I. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF ST. MICHAELS, that ORDINANCE NO. 485 entitled, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 101-BOATS AND BOATING, OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF ST. MICHAELS §101-2. MOORING AT PUBLIC WHARVES., TO REGULATE THE MOORING OF BOATS TO THE PUBLIC WHARF AT HOLLIS PARK be enacted as follows:

Amend § 101-2 Mooring at public wharves. Of the Code of the Town of St. Michaels to read as follows (new language in *italics*, *language removed-strikethrough*):

§101-2. Mooring at public wharves. No person, with the exception of commercial fishermen, shall moor a vessel at the public wharf located at the end of Mulberry Street for longer than two-four hours. Commercial fishermen may moor at the South one-half of the wharf and may raft out from the vessel moored at dockside. The municipal pier located on Harbor Road is reserved for the use of commercial fishermen. No person shall moor a vessel at the public wharf at Hollis Park for longer than four hours, and there shall be docking between the hours of 11pm and 7am.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED, that this Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days from the date of its enactment, having been read at two (2) meetings of the Commissioners of St. Michaels and having been passed by a yea ad nay vote of the Commissioners of St. Michaels.

INTRODUCED, read for the first time at the Public Meeting of the Commissioners of St. Michaels held on the 8th day of November 2017, at 6 o'clock p.m., in the meeting room of the Town Office, St. Michaels, Maryland.
