CALL TO ORDER – Roy Myers opened the meeting at 4:01pm.

Present: Roy Myers, Mark Van Fleet, Dink Daffin, Mark Welsh, John Marrah and Zoning Officer Kymberly Kudla.

Member Marrah made a motion to nominate Roy Myers to continue as Chairman. Seconded by Member Welsh and carried on a vote of 4:0 in favor.

Chairman Myers made a motion to nominate Mark Van Fleet to continue as Vice Chairman. Seconded by Member Marrah and carried on a vote of 4:0 in favor.

No minutes to approve this meeting.

Chapter 333 Proposed Amendments: Chairman Myers reviewed some proposed changes he drafted pertaining to floating platforms/floats and fixed/floating piers.

Member Welsh questioned if MDE requires permits for floats. Discussion ensued on floats as structures and permitting requirements.

Chairman Myers proceeded to review proposed changes to the definitions of floats/platforms and piers/finger piers. Discussion ensued on the number of pilings permitted and progressed to town slip requirements specifically with specifying only registered vessels permitted.

Member Welsh had to leave the meeting at 4:40pm.

Discussion moved to nonconforming structures becoming legal provided receive MDE approval.

Chairman Myers will proceed with getting MDE's input on the proposed language. .

Other Items: Discussion moved on to current town slip and shed conditions. The Board came to the consensus to remove the shed for more parking spaces and put the money towards water to slips. Member Daffin offered to talk to some of the Watermen about their thoughts on water at the slips.

The meeting adjourned at 4:58pm.
