• **Tide Staff Initiative**

Member Boicourt provided an update. Tide staffs have arrived and has contacted Town Manager regarding approval to place them. Member Boicourt explained the changes he made to the projected tidal levels he previously presented. Discussion ensued on the present and predicted levels. Chairman Myers asked him to send him a proposal of the locations for the staffs to distribute to Commissioners.

• **Review of Cherry Street/Honeymoon Bridge plan**

Brent Jett expounded on the sketch plan submitted. Aida Kahlil stated concern over the idea of a retaining wall on her property.

• **Review of 1pm Burns Street meeting**

Member Marrah gave a summary of the ideas proposed during the earlier meeting regarding the areas of The Crab Claw, Burns Street, CBMM, and the walkways. Discussion tied in Mill Street and having one master plan for the area.


• **Review of current Budget expenditures**
