**Resolution 2015-07**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF ST. MICHAELS TO AUTHORIZE  
THE INSTALLATION OF A FOUR WAY STOP SIGN AT EAST MARENGO  
AND NEW LANE**

WHEREAS, THE ST. MICHAELS CODE, Charter, enumerated section C-19, The Commissioners have the power under the protection and promotion of the health, safety, comfort, convenience, welfare and happiness of the residents of and visitors in the Town; and The Commissioners may take necessary measures herein; and

WHEREAS, THE ST. MICHAELS CODE, Charter, enumerated section C-70, The Town has control of all public ways in the Town except such as may be under the jurisdiction of the Maryland Department of Transportation subject to the laws of the State of Maryland and this Charter. The Town may do whatever it deems necessary to establish, operate and maintain in good condition the public ways of the Town; and

WHEREAS, at their meeting on July 8, 2015, the Commissioners have recognized resident concerns for traffic volume and pedestrian safety in the vicinity of East Marengo St and New Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined, in consultation with the Town Manager, that a four way stop in all directions would be the most appropriate traffic control device at the above stated location; and

WHEREAS, Maryland Transportation Code 2015 Ann. § 11-127 Highways, the entire width between the boundary lines of any way or thoroughfare of which any part is used by the public for vehicular travel, whether or not the way or thoroughfare has been dedicated to the public and accepted by any proper authority; and

WHEREAS, Maryland Transportation Code 2015 Ann. § 25-102 Powers of local authorities, (a) Enumeration of powers. -- The provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law do not prevent a local authority, in the reasonable exercise of its police power, from exercising the following powers as to highways under its jurisdiction, including regulating traffic by means of police officers or traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a four way stop shall be constructed in accordance to United States Department of Transportation Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the passage of this Resolution by a majority of The Commissioners of St. Michaels, a four way stop sign in all directions will be erected to control traffic at East Marengo and New Lane.

THIS RESOLUTION HAVING BEEN INTRODUCED AND PASSED by a yea or nay vote of the Commissioners of St. Michaels on this 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2015, becoming effective on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2015.




