A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF ST. MICHAELS ADOPTING THE 2017 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION AND COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN AS THE TOWN'S 2017 HAZARD MITIGATION AND COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN

WHEREAS, THE TOWN OF ST. MICHAELS, a Municipality of Talbot County, recognizes the Federal Disaster Act of 2000 requiring that all States and local jurisdictions develop, submit, and update hazard mitigation plans that may reduce the impacts of hazards; and

WHEREAS, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future federal funding for hazard mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of St. Michaels participated in the planning process along with other units of local government within the County to prepare the 2017 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION AND COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of St. Michaels hereby adopts the 2017 TALBOT COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION AND COMMUNITY RESILIENCE PLAN as an official plan; and


