AN EMERGENCY CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF ST. MICHAELS, PASSED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE XI-E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND, §§ 4-302(1) AND 4-304(a) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ARTICLE OF THE MARYLAND ANNOTATED CODE, AND EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20-03-30-02 OF THE GOVERNOR OF MARYLAND TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF ST. MICHAELS FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONERS OF ST. MICHAELS TO POSTPONE, BY RESOLUTION, ANY REGULAR OR SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION WHEN A STATE OF EMERGENCY HAS BEEN DECLARED BY THE GOVERNOR OF MARYLAND, TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND, AND/OR THE COMMISSIONERS OF ST. MICHAELS PURSUANT TO MD CODE ANN., PUBLIC SAFETY TITLE 14 AND UPON A FINDING THAT SUCH POSTPONEMENT IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE AND TO CONDUCT SUCH ELECTION IN A SAFE, ORDERLY, AND EFFICIENT MANNER; PROVIDING THAT THE TITLE OF THIS EMERGENCY CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION SHALL BE DEEMED A FAIR SUMMARY AND GENERALLY RELATING TO ELECTIONS IN THE TOWN OF ST. MICHAELS.
