CALL TO ORDER – Roy Myers opened the meeting at 4:00 pm.

Present: Roy Myers, Dink Daffin, Mark Van Fleet, Mark Welsh, and Zoning Officer Kymberly Kudla.

Member Van Fleet motioned to approve the minutes of March 8, 2022 as submitted. Upon a second by Member Daffin the motion passed unanimously on a vote of 4-0.

Chairman Myers would like to check on the status of the installation of water to the docks and shed removal.

Other matters from Advisory Board or Staff.

- Finalizing the ground rules and requirements for Floating Platforms and Floats

Chairman Myers received confirmation that just the area adjacent to the platform counts towards the 200 s.f. restriction. Members discussed floating platforms and the definition of recreational. Structures on platforms was also discussed. There will be an adjustment to the definition to only allow boarding assistance devices – no other structures over 3' are permitted.


Discussion of potential changes to Chapter 333, some proposed language with Mr. Breimhurst and history behind floats and platforms. Mr. Bibb asked if there were any regulations regarding how those platforms are built.

Member Welsh spoke of drive-in boat lifts, will check on the definition of boat lifts but the Board previously discussed adding mechanical to the definition.

Member Van Fleet asked if shed fees should be refunded.
