Dear Mr. Ball,

I am happy to inform you that the application to renew the Sustainable Communities designation for St. Michaels and expand the Sustainable Communities area has been approved by the Smart Growth Subcabinet. The designation lasts five years and will expire on November 20, 2028

St. Michaels will remain eligible to apply for and receive funds from several state agencies to revitalize its Sustainable Community, including the following programs from the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development:

- <u>Community Legacy Program</u>: This program provides local governments and community development
 organizations with funding for essential projects aimed at strengthening communities through activities
 such as business retention and attraction, home rehabilitation, and streetscape improvements.
- <u>Strategic Demolition Fund</u>: This program catalyzes activities that accelerate economic development, job
 production, and smart growth in existing Maryland communities. Funds can be used for capital predevelopment activities including property acquisition, site development, demolition, and constructionlevel architectural engineering designs.

I have attached to this letter a map showing the expanded boundary and additional information regarding other state programs and incentives available to Sustainable Communities.
